Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Center Township Clinton Area Sewer Extension project for Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Center Township located at 100 Municipal Drive, Rogersville PA 15359.

The funding will be used for sanitary sewerage service to 24 homes and several community stakeholders, including the Center Township Volunteer Fire Department, who currently lack access to any proper sewage. The Clinton Area of Center Township, just east of Rogersville, does not have sewage service, but instead a mixture of aging and failing on-lot septic tanks and wildcat systems that are creating an environmental hazard for the community.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project will address the health and safety concerns of the residents and is in line with the township's strategic plan. The project is currently shovel-ready, with all engineering completed and permits ready to begin construction.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
