Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Country Club Road Sewer Extension project for Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Lower Ten Mile Joint Sewer Authority, which is located at 144 Chartiers Rd. Jefferson, PA 15344.

The funding will be used to provide sewer service to approximately 14 equivalent dwelling units (EDUs) located along Country Club Road. The extension of the public sewer to the Country Club Road area will eliminate 14 aging and malfunctioning on-lot septic systems, which will reduce the likelihood of untreated or partially treated sewage discharging into the environment. Prevention of sewage discharge will help prevent negative impacts on human and environmental health in the project area.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will benefit the residents of Morgan Township, as it will increase the resilience of their wastewater infrastructure and provide relief to the surrounding environment.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
