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4. Congressional Nomination Application Form



1. QUALIFICATIONS:

To be eligible for a nomination from U.S. Representative Guy Reschenthaler you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a citizen of the United States by the time you enter a military academy
- Be a legal resident of Pennsylvania's Fourteenth Congressional District. If you have a question regarding the district, please call 724-219-4200 and ask for Sarah or visit <http://www.house.gov/> and enter your ZIP code
- Be at least 17 years old, but not yet past your 23rd birthday on July 1st of the year you enter a military academy
- Have at least STARTED an application at the military academy/academies where you are seeking a nomination
- Have earned an above average academic record
- Have achieved competitive standardized test scores (ACT/SAT)
- Have scored near or above the published averages on the Candidates Fitness Assessment (CFA)
- Be medically qualified as determined by the Department of Defense Medical Evaluation and Review Board (DoDMERB)
- Have unquestionably strong moral character and display uncompromising integrity
- Be unmarried, not pregnant, and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents

2. REQUIRED MATERIALS LIST:

1. Application for nomination form
 - a. Must be typed with a wet signature on the final page
 - b. If applied previously you must submit a new application
2. Materials from your school or college
 - a. Current class schedule (may be included on transcript)
 - b. Official academic transcripts from high school and college (if applicable)
 - c. High school disciplinary records (if you do NOT have any disciplinary records on file, please provide a letter from your school stating that)
 - d. High school attendance records – showing each year individually (may be included on transcript)
3. Standardized Test Scores (ACT/SAT)
 - a. Must be an OFFICIAL copy of test scores (However, if the test scores are showing up on your OFFICIAL high school transcript, that is sufficient)
 - b. ACT institution code: 7648
 - c. SAT institution code: 7738
4. Resume
 - a. Include extracurricular activities starting in 9th grade and employment history
5. Essay
 - a. Be no more than 3 pages, double spaced, size 12 font
 - How would your time at a service academy advance your career goals?
 - What motivates you to attend a service academy? Share your story.
 - What does service mean to you?
6. Letters of Recommendation
 - a. You must include three (3) letters
 - b. Letters should be from people who know you personally, and should attest to your character, motivation to serve and integrity
 - c. One of these must be a principal, dean, or teacher at your high school or college
 - d. Letters should be mailed directly to Congressman Reschenthaler's office (address below)
7. A current photo, no larger than wallet size. Please write your full name on the back of the photo.
8. One page explanation of your felony charges and/or convictions (if required)
